At Natura Wellness Retreat, we strive to provide our guest with a peaceful, clean, safe, and friendly experience. The following rules have been established based on industry standards, management, and operational procedures. These rules are considered a part of our reservation agreement with you. As our guest, you are agreeing to abide by all of our rules, procedures, and terms and condtions.

Check-In

3:00pm. Early check-in may be available, but is not guaranteed. Please contact Natura if you are needing an earlier check-in and we will do our best to accomodate your needs.

Check-In Requirements

Guest must be at least 21 years of age to check in at Natura. In the interest of security, guest are required to confirm their identity with a valid government issued photo identification at check-in.

Guest Registration

We require valid contact information from the guest making the reservation including; first and last name, phone number, and email address. We also require the full name of all guest of the reservation party. Information regarding your license plate/car description may also be gathered at check-in for security purposes.

Minimum Age Requirement

All guest of Natura must be a minimum of 21 years of age. A valid government issued photo ID must be presented for inspections if age appears to be in question.

Check-Out

Reservations period expires at 11am on the last day of the reservation. If you require a later checkout, please contact Natura prior to the day of departure and we will do our best to accomodate your needs.

Visitors

Only registered guest of Natura are permitted on the property. Visitor Day Passes from 9am-9pm are available for purchase at the rate of \$50/vehicle. All guest must register with the Office.

Cancellation / No Show Charges

Failure to check in on the scheduled arrival date for a reservation does not constitute a refund of payment. Natura is not responsible for weather conditions, personal emergencies, or schedule changes. Reservations must be cancelled according to the policy at the time of booking. If any refunds are to be received, it will be at Natura's discretion.

Parking

Only one car per reservation/day pass is permitted. Information regarding your license plate/car descrption will be gathered at check-in for security. Parking is only allowed in designated areas.

Quiet Hours

9:00pm-7:00am. Voices, music, and/or other devices must be kept at a respectful low level at all times. "House Parties" are not allowed at any time. If you become aware of disruptive guest, please contact our staff immediately.

Pond and Swimming Policy

For your safety and the safety of the wildlife, swimming is not permitted under any circumstance in the pond. Pond structures have a maximum capacity. No more than 2 persons are allowed on the dock at one time, and no more than 4 on the meditation pergola. No life guard on duty.

Firearms and Weapons Policy

The safety and security of our guests and staff is extremely important to us. Our Firearms and Weapons Policy is designed for the protection of our guests, vendors, staff, and owners, and pertains to the presence of firearms and weapons on any Natura property. Natura guests are not permitted to carry firearms or weapons on premises.

No Smoking Policy

For safety of our natural environment and to assure that our tents are not exposed to items or actions that create an odor which is unhealthy and objectionable to our guests, staff, and wildlife, and that is difficult to remove from the air, carpet, walls, and furniture we do not permit smoking in our tents. Smoking is allowed in the designated smoking area near the pond.

Alcohol Policy

Consumption of alcoholic beverages is limited to persons of legal age. Guest who choose to bring their own alcohol must consume in their tent area. Alcohol is not permitted in public areas such as the meditation pergola or community fire pits. Guests understand that there is to be no excessive drinking of alcohol, nor illegal drug use, and violation of this condition could result in immediate eviction of the property with no refunds given.

Lost and Found Policy

Natura assumes no liability for lost, misplaced, stolen, or damaged valuables or belongings. Items found after your departure will be held for 30 days and then donated. If you discover that you have left behind something of value, please contact our staff immediately.

Special Request

All special requests are noted on reservations and we will make every effort to honor these requests. However, the availability of items and services cannot be guaranteed.

Wi-Fi Access

Access to our Wi-Fi is free for our registered guests. The Wi-Fi access code is subject to change without notice. Wi-Fi signals are subject to change without notice depending on tent location, the status of our Wi-Fi-equipment, and interference from other local wireless signals. Natura assumes no liability for guest use.

Pets

Well behaved pets are welcomed for an additional non-refundable fee. For safety reasons, please do not leave pets unattended in the tent at any time or allow them to roam the property unsupervised. Pets are required to be on a leash at all times.

Rates

All rates are quoted in United States currency, plus tax. Rates may increase without notice.

In Case of Emergency or Fire

Please call 911 immediately and then notify our onsite staff.

Access to Property

To provide all of our guests with an exceptionally clean and safe lodging experience, we reserve the right to enter the tent for reasonable purposes, such as for housekeeping, maintenance, to verify that the room, its furnishings, and mechanical equipment are intact, or to address or prevent a violation of our House Rules. Our staff will normally announce themselves before entering your tent, unless we believe that exigent circumstances exist. Management reserves the right to enter the tent with a known status of "Do Not Disturb" in the event of an emergency, suspected illegal activity taking place, disturbing other guests, or damage being done to the property. In the event of suspected illegal activity, management reserves the right to summon law enforcement to aid in eviction. The right to privacy ends when a House Rule is broken. Law enforcement will be granted immediate access.

Indemnification

Guest acknowledges that Natura Wellness Retreat (Natura) is privately owned, including the furnishings. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone. Guest and their guests agree to INDEMNIFY and hold harmless Natura for any and all claims, including those of third parties, arising out of or any way related to guest's use of premises, or the items of personal property provided therein. Guests assume the risk of injury or other losses relating their stay within the premises as well as all outdoor amenities, both natural and manmade provided on property. This includes but is not limited to trees, water front, bridges, fences, steps, etc.... All activities both in and outside will be done at guests own risk. Guests will not hold Natura responsible for any accidents, injury, or loss of life resulting from the activities or any unforeseen events conducted on property.

Right to Refuse Service

We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone for any reason(s) that does not violate Federal or State laws. Natura has a zero tolerance policy in which we will refuse to admit, refuse service or accommodation, or may remove a person, without refund, who refuses to abide by the reasonable standards and policies established by the State of Texas and the owners for the operation and management of Natura.

Mandatory Arbitration

Any dispute under this agreement shall be required to be resolved by binding arbitration of the parties hereto. If the parties cannot agree on an arbitrator, each party shall select one arbitrator and both arbitrators shall then select a third. The third arbitrator so selected shall arbitrate said dispute. The arbitration shall be governed by the rules of the American Arbitration Association then in force and effect.

Changes or Modification To Retreat Rules

Natura reserves the right to amend, modify, change, cancel, vary or add to this agreement and content featured on our website at any time without prior notice. Please check our website regularly for updates to our Rules. Any modification to these Rules that occurs before your departure is considered a part of your reservations agreement with us. A copy of these Rules is located on our website and available from our staff upon request.

Governing Law

This agreement shall be governed by, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of the state of Texas.

Glamping Guide

Temperature

The AC unit in the glamping tent is controlled by the remote on the wall to the left of the back door. Please help us conserve energy by only running the AC/Heat when you are in the tent with the front flaps closed. Upon check-out please place the remote back in the holder.

Dehumidifyer

The dehumidifier is there to help us combat the Texas climate. It will be on when you arrive, and we ask that you keep it running during your stay for your comfort and the longevity of our tents. Please do not move the dehumidifier from its location.

Trash + Recycling

Small bins are positioned around the tent for your trash. Because we are conscious of our environmental impact, we ask that you recycle your paper, plastic, and glass items in the recycle bin on the back porch.

Kitchenette

The light in the kitchenette has a motion sensor that will come on when you open the doors. Please do not turn this light off or unplug it. The dishes and utinsles have all be sanitized prior to your stay and are ready for you to enjoy.

Coffee + Tea

Coffee and Teas are provided for you to enjoy. The electric kettle is to boil the water for the tea bags or French Press. The French Press for the coffee is located in the bottom cabinet, as well as a waste container for the used coffee grounds to be composted. Milk is also provided in the mini-fridge.

Glamping Guide

Outdoor Grill

A bag of charcoal is provided to you at check in for the outside grill. Grilling tools are located on the bottom shelf of the kitchenette. Please dispose of the ash in the container next to the grill.

Toiletries

In an effort to reduce our environmental impacts, we provide a multi-use soap bar that we make in house that can be used as body wash, shampoo, and facewash. If at any time you need more or this product, please let our staff know. If you enjoy these items, we also have full size bars available for purchase.


